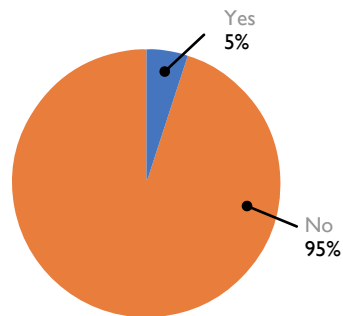

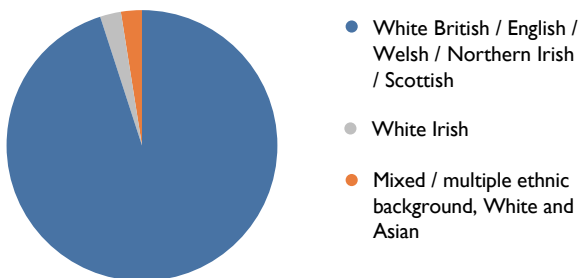

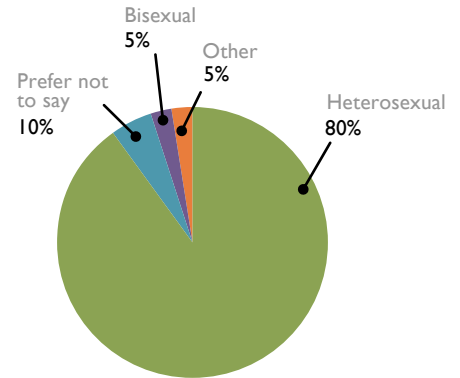

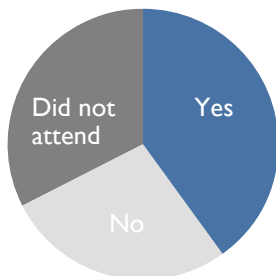

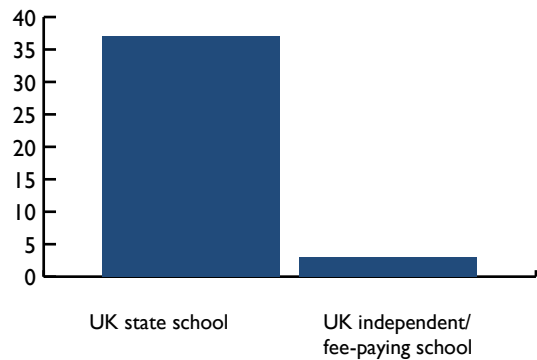

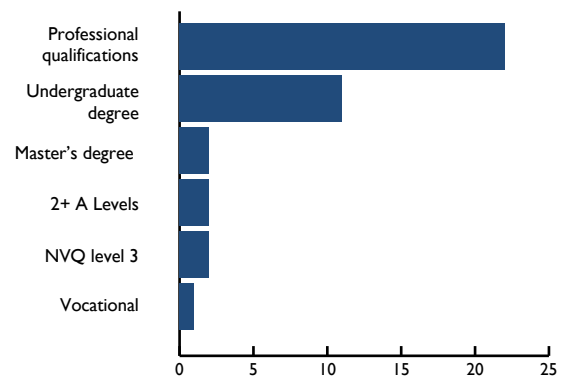

Highest level of qualification

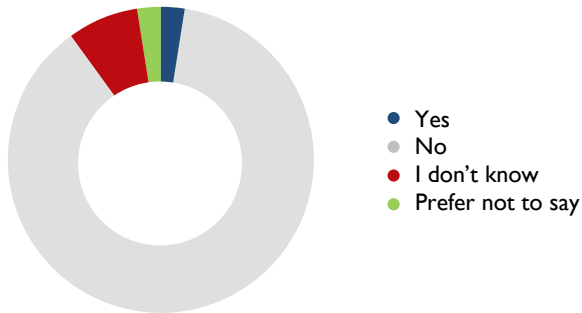

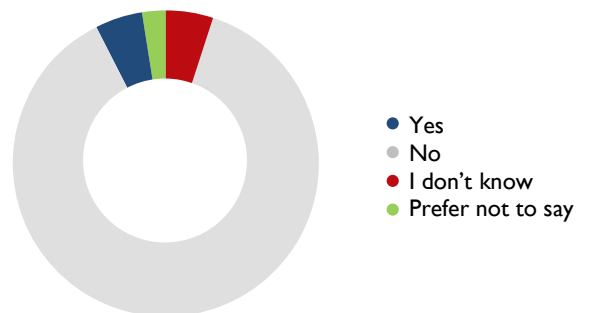
